The Dog Driven Container: The Why and The How Seminar – All Boxed up and Possession Games

This container workshop will focus on teaching the dog a dog-driven pattern – a way to for the dog to find success and not frustration in container searches. Dog-Driven patterns give the dog a task to do in the absence of odor. We will add Possession games at the end of the day. Does your dog find odor and walk away? Build value for odor using a variety of games. This workshop is appropriate for all levels. We will run from experienced dogs first down to pairing dogs.

You will work though problems while moving from exterior and interior, high and low etc. This workshop is appropriate for all levels. We will run experienced dogs first down to pairing dogs.

Michele Ellertson, CNWI, is the owner, founder, and training director at The Dog's PACE. She has been training dogs professionally for over 20 years. Although she focuses on scent training today, her background is in behavior modification. This gives her a unique perspective on engaging with all kinds of dogs. In 2009, Michele was among the first dog trainings in New England to become involved in the National Association of Canine Scent Work (NACSW) and the new sport of K9 Nosework. As such, she was instrumental in establishing the foundation necessary to make the sport a success in this region. She currently works with the NACSW as a Certifying Official, trial representative, trial host and competitor. In addition, she has an intense schedule of classes, online classes, private lessons, specialty clinics around the country as well as teaching at National K9NW Camp. Michele maintains her own knowledge by attending as many workshops as possible. Michele has trained in a variety of dog sports, both personally and professionally. However, her primary goals are in the sport of nosework. Her fondness for the sport comes from the tremendous benefits it offers to all dogs, including building confidence, bonding, mental stimulation and pure enjoyment.
